**The Enamel Guild North East is sponsoring an enamel artist exhibition at the Cape Cod Museum of Art, Dennis, MA, in conjunction with its 20th Anniversary.**

**The exhibit is open to all enamelists who reside in the US and who are current EG/NE members. The exhibition will run from November 17, 2012 through January 27, 2013.**

**DEADLINE for Entry:** Postmarked or emailed by **March 30, 2012.**

**Juror:** Linda Darty

Linda Darty is a renowned enamelist and a professor and coordinator of the metal design program at East Carolina University and has an extensive national and international exhibition record with work in the permanent collections of the Victoria and Albert Museum in London, the Museum of Arts and Design in NYC and The Arkansas Art Museum. She is the recipient of the North Carolina Board of Governor's Teaching Award as well as The Lifetime Achievement Award for Research from East Carolina University, and The Lifetime Achievement Award from The Enamelist Society, an international organization. She is also the author of *The Art of Enameling*, published by Lark books.

**Artist Submission:**

- Artists may submit up to 5 entries for an entry fee of \$25. Membership in the EG/NE is required for participation. Non-members may join for \$30. Full-time student membership is \$20 (please submit a copy of your student ID along with your entry form).
- Checks should be made payable to EG/NE. Checks should cover the cost of membership (if not currently a member) and the entry fee.

- Photos must be sent via CD or email in jpeg format at 300 dpi with the longest dimension not to exceed 6".

- Submission size: Wall Art cannot exceed 36". Objects cannot exceed 15".
- Entries that have been enhanced via Photoshop or through similar programs will not be accepted and the entry fees will not be refunded.
- All entries must be postmarked or emailed by **March 30, 2012.**
- Received entries will be acknowledged via email.

**Eligibility:**

- Enamels of all types and mixed media where the emphasis is on enamel
- Works created 2009 or later
- The exhibit is open to artists who reside in the US and who are members of EG/NE
- All works submitted must be original in design and concept. Artwork must not be copied, in part or wholly, from any published or copyrighted work.

**Notification:**

Artists will be notified of their standing by May 30th.

**Artwork Shipment:**

- Artists must mail in their artwork to the Cape Cod Museum of Art to be received by November 2, 2012.
- Details for the mailing will be provided in the acceptance email or letter.
- Cost of packing and shipping to and from the museum is the responsibility of the artist.
- Each exhibitor must sign a loan agreement with the Cape Cod Museum of Art.
- Security and insurance for the exhibit is provided by The Cape Cod Museum of Art.
