I have a large assortment of finished jewelry settings for rings, brooch's, earrings and one letter opener fabricated by David Bowie. All jewelry was fabricated by Jennifer Banks\*. Each of these pieces have a prepared blank –domed, textured, with a clear transparent layer of flux on top. Underside also enameled. They are prepared to be enameled, polished and set. Blanks are 18 or 20 gauge FS.

Most of the jewelry is a combination of 18, 22 and 24k gold. Some brooch's have either SS or bi-metal backs. All jewelry has either semi-precious or precious stones, or a combination of both. These pieces are priced at current metal prices, and with a reasonable fabrication charge. Images of these pieces can be emailed to interested parties.
